This little book is full of information. It has many of the good basic things that we need like days of the week, numbers, directions, etc. It does have some quirky phrases that might be better for another book, but all in all - especially for the price - I recommend it!

One very good thing can be said about this book is that the authors do a good job of helping an English speaker say some Khmer with some accuracy. The problem is that the book is extremely short. I counted 15 pages of common words and phrases, that's all. If you are only spending a day or two in Cambodia, this may be a good book for you. Any more than that and you will likely want something a bit more comprehensive.

If you are interested in learning Cambodian. This is a great little book for you to test the waters with. Cambodian is not the easiest language for English speakers learn, however the way the author has composed the spelling will have you speaking right from the start.

Good simple guide with some common (and some not-so-common) phrases you might need for a short stop in Cambodia.

It would be very difficult to pronounce Cambodian correctly from the transliteration system used. The phrases are all very useful but...
