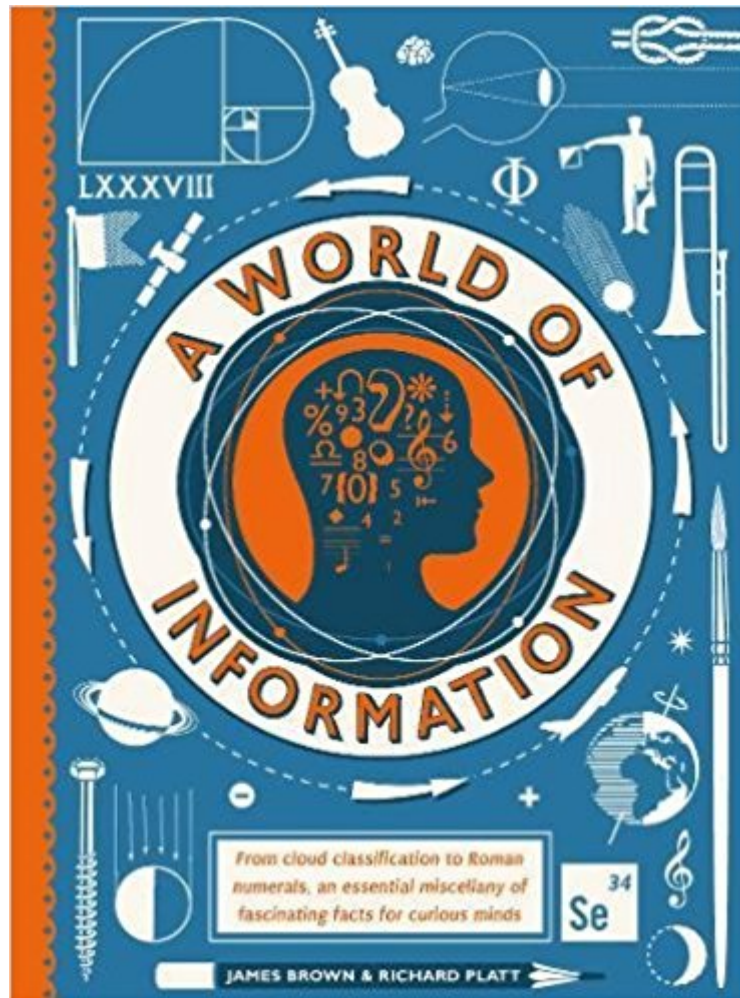

Trained as a textile and surface print designer, he worked in textiles for ten years. He then branched out into illustration and has worked with the V&A and Guardian.

A World of Information is a big, quite heavy book, that contains lots of factual information on a variety of subjects. From the Solar System, to The Human Eye, Organs of the Body to Roman Numerals, this book will have children eager to impress with the facts that they have learned. On each double, differently coloured page of the book you will find a different subject. On one side is all the factual information. On the other is the illustrations which include captions. The pictures visually show you what the factual information tells you. I particularly liked the Flag Semaphore section. We had fun trying to spell out words to one another using our makeshift flags, and performing the poses for each letter. It has been well documented that children take in and remember information if it is told in a fun, engaging manner. The use of illustrations has also been recognised as helping a child to remember. So with the combination of the two in this book, I hope children will pick up a variety of knowledge that they will remember for a long time to come.
