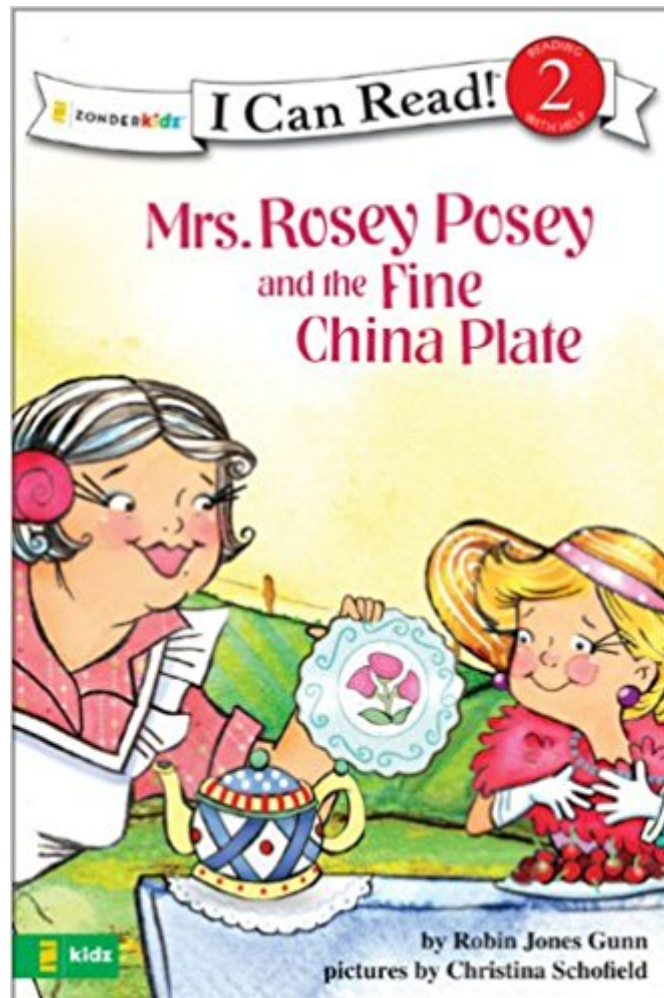

Not only is this a well-written children's story, but it also provides an excellent idea for mothers and grandmothers and aunts out there: when a special little girl in your life becomes old enough to

question why you guard her innocence and fight for her childhood, buy her a beautiful china plate and explain to her that daughters of Jesus Christ--just like special, expensive, valuable plates--should be guarded, protected, and set apart. This book will provide a nice concrete analogy of purity that a pre-teen girl can understand and appreciate . . . and receiving a fine china plate will be a memory that she will have forever. (Many women start to incorporate the plate into special family dinners, tea parties, birthdays, etc. Such a fun and meaningful tradition!)
