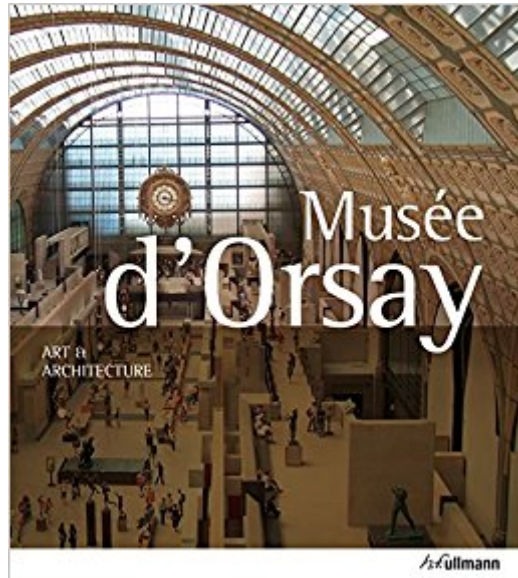

Musee d'Orsay is my absolute favourite museum and I always try to spend at least a few hours there whenever I am in Paris. It's less crowded and more visitor friendly than its more famous neighbour just across the river, the Louvre. This beautiful building started life as government offices, burnt down, was derelict for a while, was turned into a railway station, and eventually someone had the inspiration to turn it into an art museum. The history of the building is only a small part of this book - the rest is devoted to its treasures. And such treasures! The paintings, sculptures and period rooms concentrate on the glorious period from the mid-19th century to just before the First World War. Impressionism and Art Nouveau are well represented. And the light and airy building is a perfect showcase for them. This thick and slightly bulky book works both as a guide to the museum and its works (it includes floorplans) as well as a souvenir of a magical visit. Having said that, the book does not include any of the changes that occurred as part of the museum's 25th anniversary in 2011. But, as I said, most of the book is about the art and artists. I think anyone who has ever been to Musee d'Orsay will enjoy this book. And any art lover who hasn't been there will certainly want to go after discovering the delights contained in these pages. Incidentally, there is a companion book in this Art & Architecture series about the Louvre which is just as good.
