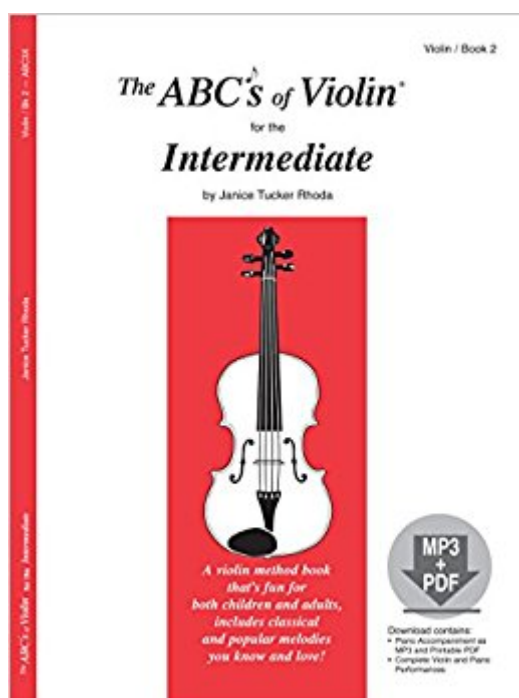

This best-selling instruction book along with download is perfect for an Intermediate player of any age on the Violin. The many melodies plus short warm-up exercises and study pieces advance students technically in an easy and enjoyable way. It includes graphs to show new left-hand finger placement, a note-reading worksheet, and practice chart. As a direct continuation of the ABCs of Violin for the Absolute Beginner, Book 1, students will learn additional slurred bowing techniques and rhythms, new major and minor scales, and new key and time signatures. Flat key signatures are introduced in an easy, logical manner. The included digital download consists of three components: 35 mp3 performance pieces of violin solo with piano accompaniments, 35 mp3 piano accompaniment tracks by themselves for play-along, and a printable pdf file of the piano accompaniments. When I started teaching the violin years ago, I used these books as companions to the Suzuki books. They are a nice, simple way to introduce concepts one at a time. I am equally pleased with the viola books. The books are easier than the Suzuki books, so I use these to introduce a concept, then teach the Suzuki song that accompanies the skill. Highly recommend. If you are trying to learn the viola and already have prior musical experience, you can probably use these books to teach yourself. If you have no musical experience at all, you will probably need an instructor to get you through them.

This is the book I am using currently. This book series gets you playing in a very short amount of time. I can now play music with the violin that is generic sheet music. I think I am on my third month of learning to play the violin. Not too bad for a senior citizen learning new things. You need to start

with Book 1 of the series first.

"Intermediate" means exactly that...assumes you have familiarity with reading music and playing your violin. Practice, practice, practice, and, hopefully, after you've mastered the music in this lesson book you and your calloused fingers will be ready for more advanced fare.

I bought the more expensive, "Sheet Music" version of this book because it came with a CD. The CD was supposed to have audio files and a PDF document. It turns out that whoever made the CD did include two copies of that PDF file, but forgot to add the audio files. Since I do not play the piano, I do not own a piano, or play in the company of anyone who has a piano, that PDF file is next to useless for me, right now, and with no audio files, which I would have used to listen to the tunes in the book to hear if I am playing them right, that CD, that I paid extra to get, is useless! Feeling ripped-off! At least the lesson book has print on its pages, although the quality of this book is not as good as the quality of the first book in the series.
