I've purchased three different books about using Photos and this one appears to be the best one yet. It's too bad that I don't have the option of adding another half-star for ratings and I hesitate to give anything five stars. The book is rather detailed in its descriptions of the editing process and it includes some abbreviated instructions for a few of the extensions from the App Store. The editing

section, in particular, provides lots of good tips and suggestions for editing my pictures, and I've found that they work well with both RAW and JPEG photos. Other sections of the book are fairly comparable to other books I've purchased.

I found this book very useful on getting started and quickly up to speed with Photos. I had in the past used Aperture and iPhotos. Photos is similar yet different. What the author does is explain in a casual style how it is different. For instance, the author explains Photos does not use the classic database. The photos way is more like a shoebox with all your photos in it. The application uses tags be they date, people, location etc. So when one searches they need only enter "cars" to pull up all the images of cars. Photos even has the ability to help you by asking you questions such as "Who is this person?" The author uses metaphors such as the shoebox to make it easy to understand. A section of the book that was a big help was extensions. He gives his thoughts and opinions on many of them and it helps you understand how they can help you. They extensions range from Filters, HDR effects to more advanced ones for use with DSLRs that allow lens correction (even aperture did not allow that) and advanced editing functions. I found the book was an important tool to help me to get the most out of the application. I did not read it chapter by chapter, but as I played with the application, I would reference the book. I appreciated that the book allowed me to work that way as for myself it helps me learn faster. The author has taught me through his words that Photos is like an onion as one peels away the layers more of the depth is revealed as you need it. I was given the book by the author to review and these opinions are my honest and sincere thoughts... Its a great book if your a Mac users and all interested in Photos and getting the most out of it

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
