PAUL HARVEY was an American radio broadcaster. For decades, his programs reached as many as 24 million people each week. He was known for personalizing the news with his opinions. The speech "So God Made a Farmer," delivered to the 1978 Future Farmers of America Convention, struck a chord with its emotional tribute to the American farmer. Harvey was also known for the radio series *The Rest of the Story*, described as a blend of mystery and history.

The book is wonderful; it has some amazing pictures that really capture the life of a farmer. It is more of a coffee table book, though. There are some tidbits of information about the photographers, but not much actual reading material. Most of the pictures have a line of information indicating where the picture was taken and on who's farm, but there isn't really any direct information about the farmers, their lives, or what they do. If they had included the occasional page of information on

what has driven that particular person to keep the farming tradition alive or some hardships they have had to endure, that would have pushed the book over the edge and I'd have given it five stars. Amazing photography from very talented people though.
