

I am really enjoying each book in Part 2 of The Frontiers Saga so far. The world building has been excellent as has the plotting of the story. Instead of the full on action of Part 1 which had a high level of battle action, part 2 is slowly building momentum towards what will happen in the proceeding books. Now, I'm not saying there's no action because there is - it is just at a different level. In part this has been needful - hence the couple of books dealing with the return of Nathan. Now the question is, 'how do you effectively engage in a rebellion, with limited military resources, against the

powerful Dusahn. Essentially, you do what Nathan does in this latest episode: you look for allies and resources. I really liked the new characters we get to know in this latest episode - the whole culture of the Rakuen Gunyoki fighters was interesting and I liked the Miyagi-like Koku. Coupled with a new plot thread - let's just say, it involves Galiardi stooping to all new lows - and a fantastic action scene at the end earned a huge thumbs up for me for its tension - had me on the edge of my seat.

Looking forward to the next episode :)

Although it felt a little slow in parts, it was difficult to put down this continuing tale of Nathan Scott. While questioning himself is clearly part of his character, one hopes he does it significantly less after this book. It's starting to feel as tiresome as it appears to for the other main characters. Hopefully the next episode will be out well before Christmas and we will see where the clearly stated loose ends lead.

So this is how it goes down. First, I get notified a new book is available. Next I instantly purchase the book. If I'm reading something else, well too bad because I'm going to read the new book next. And finally we come to the end of the novel and I'm left anxiously waiting the next book. These are fun books, I'd recommend starting at the beginning and read them all.
