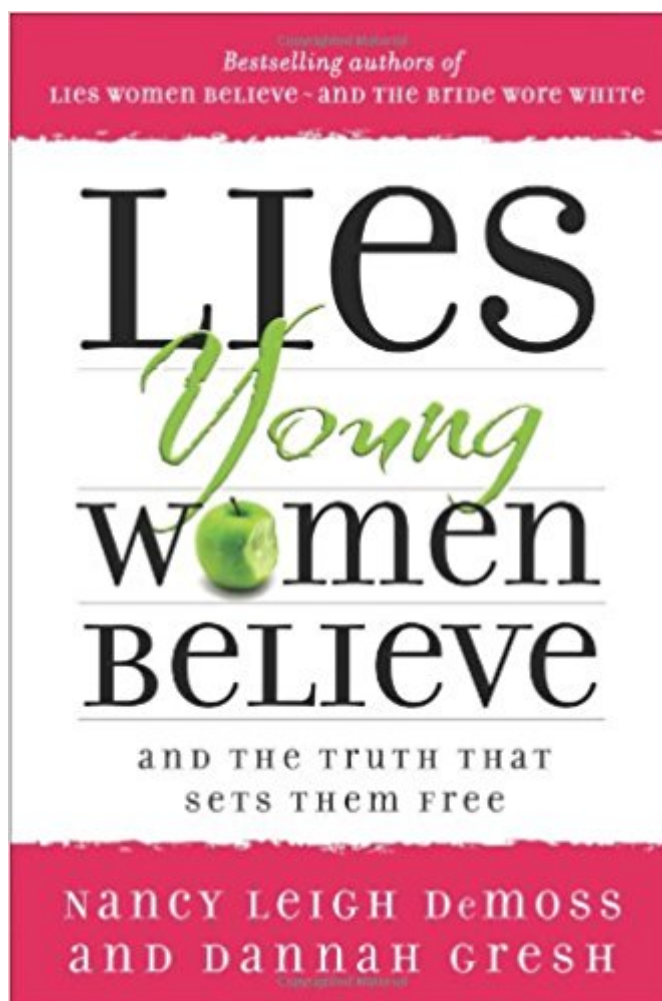

I've given this to my daughters to help them discern biblical truth about their role as a woman versus what society today tells them. If you're a Christian family with teen-age daughters, I highly recommend this study. It does have more impact when another female adult mentor walks through this with them.

I will definitely recommend this book to others.
