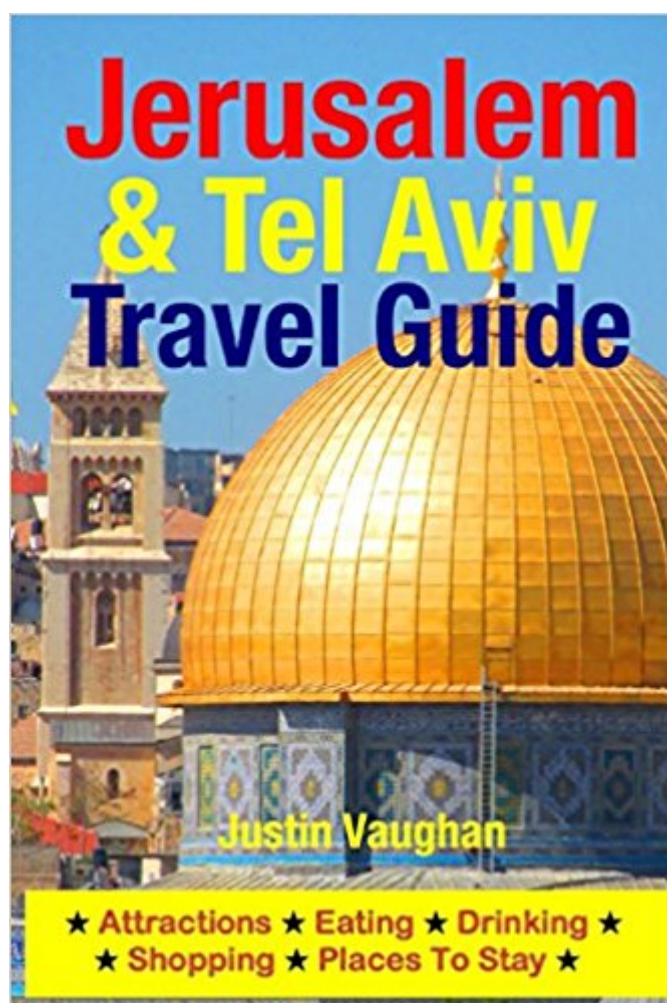

The book contains useful but limited information. It is printed in a large font like the large-print library books so if you have visual problems this would be great. It is like several pages of a Frommer's or Fodor's guide expanded to a 6x9", 72-page size. It is too large to carry in a purse or pocket. To me it feels like a tour guide's talk transcribed into book form. If it were half the size and half the price I would have felt it was a good buy. I also bought "An Illustrated Guide to the Holy Land for Tour Groups, Students, and Pilgrims" by Lamontte Luke and "A Historical Tour of the Holy Land" by Beryl Ratzer, both of which I really like. The Illustrated Guide is small enough to put in a purse and lists all the places to see and their history. A Historical Tour is much larger, with beautiful illustrations, and is more for the history before you tour.
