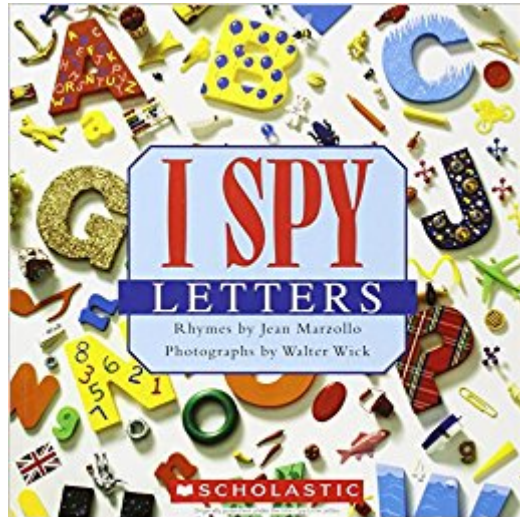

Sadly, there is nothing to spy in this book. Nothing is hidden, the letters are just right there. Just sitting there on a blank, white page. No searching whatsoever. The age range for this book is listed as 3-5. Wrong. My 2-year old isn't even amused. So, if you are looking for a letter book, I do think

this one is nice, but don't buy this if you are expecting the typical "I Spy" format.

Wonderful book! My 2 year old daughter adores I Spy books. She really finds these books entertaining! She will sit with me and read "I Spy" And find the objects listed. I Spy books have helped her with object recognition. She will look around the room now and say "I Spy a red book" to play games with me! She started reading I Spy when she was a little younger than 2!

I purchased this for my classroom, thinking the students would have to actually "search" for the letters. They are just on the page and you don't even have to look for them. The description did not let you look inside the book to take a look so I wasn't sure but figured it was like other "I Spy" books. Very disappointed and a waste of money.

My son (2.5 years old) loves these books. He reads them over and over. It's helping him identify his letters. They are pretty easy but they are aimed for pre-schoolers. I think this would be too easy for kids over the age of 4. I also try to ask him questions about the other items on the page to help him associate the letter with objects that start with it.

Great book. The pages are smaller and not as jumbled with things to spy as the hardback books are; but still, for my 3 year old who is learning her numbers and letters, this book is gonna make a great gift.
