

This book is acceptable. It provides helpful clues about each species as well as a measurement that can be useful. However, I have found that an entire species is missing from this book! After only a

few weeks of use this tells me that there might be much missing!!! As well they sometimes only provide the upper wing pattern which is not going to help identify some skippers, blues, etc. The Kauffman guide is exponentially better when it comes to depictions, however this provides better descriptions of species like skippers that don't photograph well. The species missing is the Common Checkered Skipper.

The Peterson's guides are a must have for anyone to spend time outdoors and want to be aware of the flora and fauna around. We own a large collection and bought this to supplement the old copy we had. Comprehensive and in depth.
