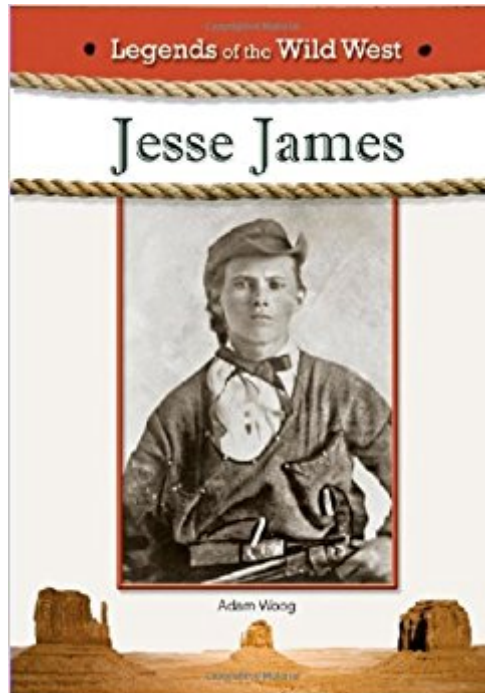




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Jesse James (Legends Of The Wild West)
