

Mostly of interest for people interested in the Baha'i Faith, and their friends and well-wishers. For a

few brief decades a handful of individuals were appointed to assist the Baha'i communities all over the world. Their title was "the Hands of the Cause". Now that they have all passed into the Kingdom of Light (afterlife/heaven), there will never be any more. They were truly unique in every way. Far from being proud of this title, they were some of the most humble, endearing, supportive, and encouraging people ever. This book consists of very informal, diary-like entries of the author's personal experiences meeting several of them over a period of years. There are a couple of ways this book could be useful. For future historians looking into this faith, these informal sources can offer insights into the impact of these few individuals on an evolving world religion. For the rest of us, it is such a joy to experience these lovely, kind, cherished people once again. For both groups, there are some real gems consisting of the letters written to the author's family during a very dark time in their lives. Mr. Faizi makes it emphatically clear that God is primarily the Loving and the Most Merciful. That, for example, a failure to perform some beneficial task would never, ever cause harm to befall one's family. This is a lovely book, and I recommend it.
